How? 1. Visit v2.4honline.com

- 2. Existing login and member info has been transferred from the previous system. So only new families/volunteers need to create an account profile
- 3. When selecting payment method, choose "Payment for this invoice will be collected by 4-H institution". Click confirm, BUT do not send a check for payment. The fee is covered!


